賽事類別及參加資格 (不得同時報名兩個組別或以上)

(A1) 兒童組 (I) 個人賽 (6-9 歲男女子混合)

- 無分級、段位或國籍
- 每局以 2 分鐘為限,「三分定勝負」
- (四強及以前的比賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。
- (決賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,會立即進行延長戰,時間為 2 分鐘,先取一分者勝出。如果未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。

(A2) 兒童組 (II) 個人賽 (10-12 歲男女子混合)

- 無分級、段位或國籍
- 每局以 2 分鐘為限,「三分定勝負」
- (四強及以前的比賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。
- (決賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,會立即進行延長戰,時間為 2 分鐘,先取一分者勝出。如果未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。

(B) 男子少年組個人賽 (13-17 歲)

- 無分級、段位或國籍
- 每局以 2 分鐘為限,「三分定勝負」
- (四強及以前的比賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。
- (決賽)限時內若未能分出勝負,會立即進行延長戰,時間為 2 分鐘,先取一分者勝出。如果未能分出勝負,3 名審判根據選手的精神及氣合(Kiai)作出判定,獲較多旗幟者為勝方。

(C) 女子少年組個人賽 (13-17 歲)

- (決賽)限時內若未能分出勝負，會立即進行延長戰，延長戰無時間限制，先取一分者為勝方。

(H) 男子公開組個人賽(18-70 歲，無段位限制)

- 參加選手無段位限制，無分國籍
- 每局以 3 分鐘為限，「三分定勝負」

- (四強及以前的比賽)如果在限時內未能分出勝負，將立即進行延長戰，時間為 3 分鐘，先取一分者勝出。如果仍然未能分出勝負，將再進行第二次延長戰，時間同樣為 3 分鐘。如果再一次未能分出勝負，則由 3 名審判根據選手的姿勢、技術、以及是否獲得反則(Hansoku)作出判定，獲得較多旗幟者為勝方。

2. 每位參加者，只可以參加一項賽事。
3. 選手段位會以截止報名日期(2026 年 5 月 19 日)或之前所考得的最高段位為準。
4. **有意參加者必須經屬會報名，屬會負責人請填妥附件中的報名表格，以電郵方式寄回本會。截止報名日期：2026 年 5 月 19 日(星期二)，中午 12 時正**
5. 所有賽事(由初賽至決賽)將採用小組或淘汰賽形式進行。主辦單位保留對採用任何比賽形式的最終決定權。
6. 每一組賽事，冠、亞及雙季軍均獲頒發獎牌。另外，各個組別均設有敢鬪獎。
7. **主辦單位可因應個別賽事設定獎項數目。**
8. 所有參賽選手所使用的竹劍將會進行竹劍檢定，檢定後會蓋上不同的顏色的蓋印，以分辨及確定男女選手所用竹劍合乎賽事規格。兒童組別竹刀亦必須進行安全檢定。

10. 如活動期間遺失個人物品，主辦單位概不負責。
11. 主辦單位保留對任何參賽、審判及工作人員申請的最終決定權。

Event Categories and Entry Requirements (No registering for two groups or above at the same time)

(A1) Children Individual (I) (Age 6-9, Mixed)

- Any nationalities and any Kyu / Dan
- All matches will be at 2 minutes duration, each match will be played by “3 Bon-Shobu”
- (Semi-final and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and kiai. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and Kiai (気合). The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(A2) Children Individual (II) (Age 10-12, Mixed)

- Any nationalities and any Kyu/ Dan
- All matches will be at 2 minutes duration, each match will be played by “3 Bon-Shobu”
- (Semi-final and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and kiai. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and Kiai (気合). The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(B) Male Teenage Individual (Age 13 – 17)

- Any nationalities and any Kyu / Dan
- All matches will be at 2 minutes duration, each match will be played by “3 Bon-Shobu”
- **(Semi-final and prior rounds)** If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and kiai. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- **(Final)** If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and Kiai (気合). The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.

(C) Female Teenage Individual (Age 13 – 17)

- Any nationalities and any Kyu / Dan
- All matches will be at 2 minutes duration, each match will be played by “3 Bon-Shobu”
- **(Semi-final and prior rounds)** If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, the three referees will make a decision (Hantei) based on the players' spirit and kiai. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- **(Final)** If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an extension match (Encho) will immediately take place, lasting 2 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. - All matches will be at 3 minutes duration, each match will be played by “3 Bon-Shobu”
- **(Semi-finals and prior rounds)** If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the players' posture, techniques, and any fouls committed. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- **(Final)** If a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed until a player who will first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.

(E) Women's Open Individual (Aged 18-70, No Dan Restriction)

- Any nationalities with no Dan restriction
- All matches will be at 3 minutes duration, each match will be played by "3 Bon-Shobu"
- (Semi-finals and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the players' posture, techniques, and any fouls committed. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed until a player who will first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.

(F) Men's Individual (Aged 18-70, No Dan – 2 Dan)

- Any nationalities with No Dan – 2 Dan
- All matches will be at 3 minutes duration, each match will be played by "3 Bon-Shobu"
- (Semi-finals and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the players' posture, techniques, and any fouls committed. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed until a player who will first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.

(G) Men's Individual (Aged 18-70, 3 Dan – 4 Dan)

- Any nationalities with 3 Dan – 4 Dan
- All matches will be at 3 minutes duration, each match will be played by "3 Bon-Shobu"
- (Semi-finals and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the players' posture, techniques, and any fouls committed. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed until a player who will first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.

(H) Men's Open Individual (Aged 18-70, No Dan Restriction)

- Any nationalities with no Dan restriction
- All matches will be at 3 minutes duration, each match will be played by "3 Bon-Shobu"
- (Semi-finals and prior rounds) If a winner cannot be determined within the time limit, an Encho match will immediately take place, lasting 3 minutes, with the first to get Ippon declared the winner. If a winner is still not determined, a second Encho match will occur, also lasting 3 minutes. If there is still no winner after this second extension, the decision will be made by the three referees based on the players' posture, techniques, and any fouls committed. The player with the most flags will be declared the winner.
- (Final) If a winner cannot be decided within the 3 minutes duration, Encho will proceed until a player who will first get Ippon will be winner. There is no time limit in the Encho.

Rules & Regulations

(Please read carefully)

1. Entry Fee: HK\$250 per person (Payment includes competition and personal accident insurance. This competition **does not provide** lunch box.) All payment should be made on or before 19th May 2025. Please kindly noted that Alipay will charge 1.5% administration charges. The fee amounted to total \$254HKD.
2. Each participant can take part in ONE category only.
3. Player's dan level will be based on the highest dan achieved by the registration deadline (19th May, 2026,) or before.
4. **Interested individuals MUST register through dojo representatives by email. Registration Deadline: 19^h May 2026 (Tuesday), 12:00pm**
5. All competitions (from preliminary rounds to finals) will be conducted in either a group or knockout format. The organizing committee reserves the final decision on the choice of any competition format.
6. Medals will be given to winner, 2nd place and two 3rd places in each event. There will be fighting spirit awards as well in each category.
7. The organizing committee may determine the number of awards for each event.
8. Shinai check – all shinai will have to be checked on the day and stamped with different colours for identification of men and women events. Children's shinai will also be checked for safety.
9. The organizing committee will set up a first aid team at the venue during the tournament.
10. The organizing committee will not be held responsible for any loss of personal belongings during the tournament.
11. The organizing committee reserves the right to retain any veto for any entry and application.
12. The organizing committee reserves the right to amend the rules of the Competition if necessary. The rules announced on the day of the tournament shall prevail.
13. All matches shall be conducted following "The Regulations of Kendo Shiai & Shinpan of FIK" revised on 2nd September, 2017 and thereafter.
14. The HKKA executive committee reserves the right to final amendment and interpretation in respect of the above terms.

Weight of Shinai:

Male - 510g & above (Aged 17 or below - 440g & above)

Female - 440g & above (Aged 17 or below female - 400g & above)

Length: Not longer than 120cm (Aged 17 or below - not longer than 114cm)

Diameter of Sakigawa: Male - 26mm & above (Aged 17 or below - 25mm & above)

Female - 25mm & above (Aged 17 or below - 24mm & above)

Sakigawa Length: 50mm & above

Standards for Shinai (Nito-no-kamae)

Daito Weight (Longer Sword): Male - 440g & above; Female - 400g & above

Shoto Weight (Shorter Sword): Male - 280g – 300g; Female - 250g – 280g

Daito Length (Longer Sword): Not longer than 114cm

Shoto Length (Shorter Sword): Not longer than 62cm
